LITANY

- C: but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- P: (*Ephesians 2:8*) It is by grace you have been saved, through faith—
- C: and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- C: and glorify him with thanksgiving.
