

SERMON Romans 1:1–7

<sup>1</sup>Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God, <sup>2</sup>which he promised in advance through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures. <sup>3</sup>This gospel is about his Son—who in the flesh was born a descendant of David, <sup>4</sup>who in the spirit of holiness was declared to be God's powerful Son by his resurrection from the dead—Jesus Christ, our Lord. <sup>5</sup>Through him we received grace and the call to be an apostle on behalf of his name, to bring about the obedience of faith among all the Gentiles, <sup>6</sup>including you, who were called by Jesus Christ.

<sup>7</sup>To all those loved by God who are in Rome, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

## I. The Savior Is a Child

#### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Grades 2 and 3

- Q: Who is Christ?
  - A: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God (John 1:1).
- Q: Where was this little child born?
  - A: But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times (Micah 5:2).

Q: Who was his mother?

A: Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel (Isaiah 7:14).

Q: Where was Mary's home?

A: In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary (Luke 1:26–27).

Q: Who was this child's earthly father?

A: But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit (Matthew 1:20).

A: He was born in Bethlehem, the town of David.

**CHRISTMAS GOSPEL** 

Luke 2:1–7 | *Grades 7 and 8* 

Kindergarten and Grade 1

O: What is the name of this child?

A: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel"—which means "God with us" (Matthew 1:23).

A: She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins (Matthew 1:21).

A: The holy one to be born will be called the Son of God (Luke 1:35).

A: For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost (Luke 19:10).

#### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Grades 4, 5, and 6

Q: Who is this Christ-child?

A: For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form (Colossians 2:9).

A: For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all people (1 Timothy 2:5–6).

A: But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law (Galatians 4:4–5).

A: Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).

Q: What has this Christ-child done for us?

A: This is how God showed his love among us: he sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him (1 John 4:9).

A: Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners (1 Timothy 1:15).

A: For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich (2 Corinthians 8:9).

- P: Why has God redeemed us?
- C: In order that I might be his own, live under him in his kingdom, and serve him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness.
- P: How do we know this?
- C: Even as he is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.
