### **CREED**

Apostles' Creed, Second Article

- P: Let us confess our holy faith in the incarnate God using the words of the Second Article of the Apostles' Creed and Martin Luther's explanation of it.
- C: I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he shall come to judge the living and the dead.
- P: What does this mean?
- C: I believe that Jesus Christ is true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary; and that he is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, purchased and won me from all sins, from death and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with his holy, precious blood, and with his innocent suffering and death; in order that I might be his own, live under him in his kingdom, and serve him in everlasting righteousness, innocence and blessedness; even as he is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.
